Supporting EU nationals within the Gatwick Family

With the possibility Britain will leave the EU on 29 March 2019, Gatwick is hosting FREE information sessions to equip eligible airport workers with the information they need to continue living and working in the UK.

For EU nationals to remain here, they must apply for the Government's [EU Settlement Scheme](#), even if they have permanent residence.

Gatwick will have professional advice available at sessions held in the Hilton Hotel in South Terminal. We want to offer some certainty to our colleagues in an uncertain time and help to guide them through the process.

How to register

We've partnered with employment lawyers and immigration experts to provide free, professional advice and support on a first-come, first-served basis. EU nationals can apply for the Settlement Scheme from 30 March 2019.

- 1. We recommend that you identify the EU nationals in your Gatwick-based teams and organise a representative to attend on their behalf .**
